Spanish-language and sign language interpreters can be made available at the meeting by notifying the co-op by April 20.



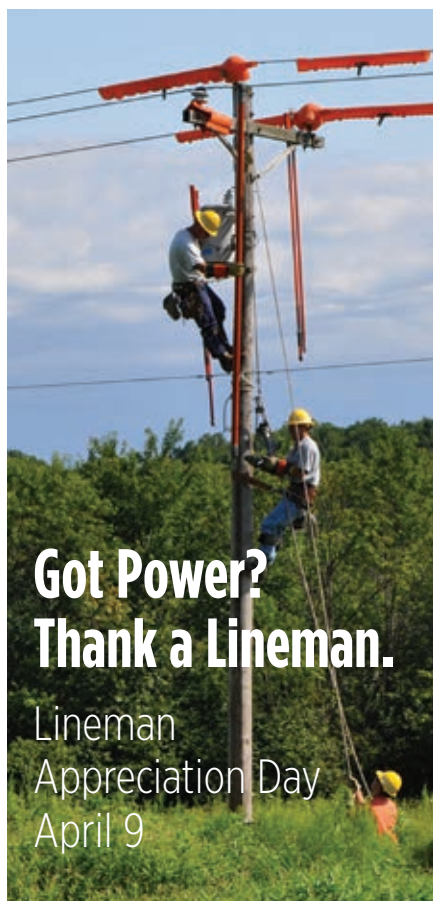
